TARIFF 1 – TARIFF OF DUES OF HPA S.A. ON SHIPS – VEHICLES – PASSENGERS

I) RIGHTS ON BOARD SHIPS

A. PORT DUES – CARGO AND CRUISE VESSELS (RECIPROCITY BASIS)

1. BERTHING DUES

Berthing dues are reciprocal and calculated per vessel call based on the vessel's Gross Tonnage (GT) as follows:

2. PORT DUES

Quay dues are calculated per day and per meter of the vessel's maximum length alongside the quay as follows:

	SHIP CATEGORY	PRICES €
1.	Cargo ships	0.20 € per meter of LOA per day
2.	Cruise ships	0.80 € per meter of LOA per day
3.	Unauthorized berthing alongside quay	1.50 € per meter of LOA per day

3. STERN BERTHING DUES

They are set at 35% of the corresponding quay dues.

B. BERTHING DUES FOR PROFESSIONAL AND PRIVATE TOURIST PLEASURE BOATS AND PROFESSIONAL AND AMATEUR FISHING BOATS

HPA S.A. must:

- To inform port users that they must declare to the competent department the period they wish their vessels to dock.
- To ensure in a timely manner the determination of berthing positions in the area of its responsibility, and to carry out the inspection and registration of the vessels moored in its area.

C. SPECIAL CASES OF QUAY FEES

1. Single quay fee of €2.00 / meter / day for passenger and passenger-vehicle vessels operating passenger-vehicle services.
2. For special purpose ships, such as warships, non-merchant ships, research ships or other special purpose ships, which operate within the Port Zone of Heraklion and make exclusive use of a pier for their service needs, a fee for the use of port facilities amounting to three hundred euros (€300), plus VAT, is imposed per calendar day. Each part of a calendar day is counted as a full day.

D. WRECK DUES

1. Floating constructions of any category that are completely or partially submerged on the seabed of the sea included in the port area as shipwrecks, are charged with dues calculated for each day and per gross tonnage as follows:

From 3 months to 6 months	0.07€/GT
Over 6 months	0.14€/GT

2. Shipowners of floating structures that have been completely or partially submerged or third parties who own them, in the maritime area of HPA S.A., are obliged, after prior written notice within a reasonable period of time, to proceed to lift them. Otherwise, HPA S.A. may, at his own expense, proceed to the recovery and claim the payment of appropriate compensation.
3. For the light marking of the above shipwrecks, HPA S.A., through the Lighthouse Service, shall proceed with the installation, with the cost charged to the responsible party.
4. In the event that an application for the recovery / dismantling of the wreck is submitted, HPA S.A. By its decision, it determines the terms of execution and the period of completion of the entire project.

E. RIGHTS OF ABANDONED SHIPS

Ships that are abandoned by the owners-agents, etc. or for which their removal from the sea or land zone of jurisdiction of the Port of Heraklion has been requested or are characterized by HPA S.A. as dangerous and harmful to the Port of Heraklion and do not comply with the instructions of the Organization or the K.L.I. will be imposed on them five (5) times the applicable dues and an immediate procedure for their removal will be applied by the Port Services Directorate unilaterally with a charge expenses to the owner by the Directorate of Financial Services.

F. MOORING RIGHTS OF FLOATING STRUCTURES

- The following specially adapted and intended floating shipyards that remain in the sea area of HPA S.A. for the execution of various works, are charged only with berthing rights, calculated per month, as follows:

- The above specially adapted and intended floating structures, which perform various works or those intended for this purpose, must necessarily be notified by the interested parties to the competent Service of HPA S.A.

The above fees determined on a case-by-case basis are paid even if the floating structures referred to therein are not in operation throughout the month, with the exception of cases of repair or retrofitting of these structures, in which case the relevant tariff applies.

Exemptions :

The following are exempt from the payment of the dues referred to in this paragraph:

- Warships and state non-commercial vessels (educational, etc.), whether Greek or foreign, calling at Greek ports, as well as vessels belonging to International Organizations, Humanitarian or Environmental Organizations, Foundations, Research Institutions, etc.
- Passenger vessels (P/V) and passenger-vehicle vessels (P/V-R/V) of any type performing scheduled services, in cases of emergency calls at ports, in accordance with Article 7, paragraph 2 of Law 2932/2001 (Government Gazette A'145).
- Vessels or floating structures used for the execution of works in the Port of Heraklion shall be granted a fifty percent (50%) discount.
- Vessels owned by the Hellenic State and operating on its behalf.
- Vessels owned by or placed at the disposal of foreign Heads of State.

The above passenger dues are collected by the Heraklion Port Authority S.A. A minimum total passenger fee, regardless of the actual number of passengers transported per approach, is set at one thousand euros (€1.000).

The above minimum total passenger charge is set for the purpose of covering the fixed operating and operational costs of the Heraklion Port Authority S.A. related to the provision of port services to cruise ships, regardless of the actual number of passengers handled, and is applied in accordance with the principles of objectivity, transparency and non-discrimination of port users.

TARIFF 2 – LIFTING/LAUNCHING OF BOATS

Remarks:

1. In all the above cases, if the duration of the work exceeds one hour, an additional charge is imposed for the hourly use of the machines employed beyond the initial time. The charge is made in indivisible hourly units, without the possibility of apportionment, and each employment, regardless of duration, is considered and charged as full time.
2. A 15% discount on all prices in the above table (except for the additional charge for hourly use) is provided to the members of Associations, whose detailed data will be received by HPA under the responsibility of their Presidents.

SURCHARGES

The tariffs in the above table are valid from Monday to Friday from 07.30 to 15.00 (normal work). For services provided beyond the above days & hours (temporary work) the following surcharges apply:

DISCOUNT 50% : From Monday to Friday from 15.00 to 22.00 & Saturdays from 07.30 to 15.00.

INCREASE 75%: From Monday to Friday from 22.00 to 07.30 (night) & Saturdays from 15.00 to 07.30.

100% SURCHARGE : For Sundays and holidays from 07.30 to 24.00.

All the above prices are subject to additional VAT.

C. -For the use of a slide, the amount of € 10.00 per movement, for the entry or exit of a boat, with a 50% discount per movement to the members of Associations, whose detailed data will be received by HPA under the responsibility of their Presidents.

-For the concession of the use of a trailer stay, the amount of € 5.00 per day, based on the calendar and not the twenty-four hours. Each date change implies a new charge day.

D. Boat base movement with the amount of € 100.00 per movement.

All the above prices are subject to additional VAT.

TARIFF 11 – WEIGHING CHARGES

Every vehicle for the transport of goods, truck of any type, loaded or empty, that enters the land zone of the Port, is subject to weighing through the weighbridge of HPA S.A. and to the payment of the prescribed fee for its use, either for weighing cargo or for checking the weight of the vehicle, following an order of HPA S.A., the Port Authority or other competent public authority.

The weighing and payment of the relevant right applies regardless of whether the vehicle is carrying a load or not and regardless of the purpose of the weighing.

HPA S.A., through its competent bodies, reserves the right to demand the weighing of any vehicle or cargo and the payment of the corresponding fee, in the context of monitoring the movement of goods through the Port and verifying the declared data.

B. PARKING SPACE 2

First three (3) hours: €3.00. Each additional hour: €0.40 Maximum daily charge (after 10 hours): €10.00. Free stay: twenty (20) minutes

Multi-Day Parking

Two (2) days: €15.00

Three (3) days: €21.00

Five (5) days: €31.00

Beyond five (5) days: €5.00 per additional day

Monthly Card

Monthly card: €65.00

Monthly Heraklion Port Authority partner card: €40.00

C. PARKING SPACE 3

First three (3) hours: €3.00 Each additional hour: €0.40 Maximum charge per day (after 10 hours): €10.00

Multi-Day Parking

D. Persons with Disabilities

Parking is provided free of charge to holders of a valid disability card, in the specially designed spaces.

**TARIFF 15 – TARIFF OF TRACTORS & TRAILERS OF VEHICLES OWNED BY HPA S.A. & INDIVIDUALS –
ENTRY OF VEHICLES FOR THE EXECUTION OF VARIOUS WORKS**

ENTRANCE TO THE PORT TO PERFORM VARIOUS TASKS

For each entry into the Port for the execution of works (provision of services) such as ship supply, provision of fuel, water, waste collection, passenger transport, all kinds of repairs, etc., a fee corresponding to the above is set in favor of HPA S.A. as follows:

All the above prices are subject to additional VAT.

Remarks:

1. The sale of newspapers, cigarettes and phone cards is excluded from the daily entry fee for the supply of passenger cars, due to the lack of profit.
2. Anyone entering the Port without a permit will be subject to a financial charge amounting to 20 times the value of the annual fee.

TARIFF 16 – CONCESSION OF USE OF AREAS WITHIN THE PORT

The Heraklion Port Authority S.A. may grant the use of land areas, outdoor or covered, within the Port Zone and the areas under its jurisdiction, for activities related to port services, handling and transport of goods, including but not limited to storage, simple processing, packaging, unpackaging and provision of value-added services, for a monthly fee or another agreed price, in accordance with the Concession Agreement ratified by Law 5126/2024.

The specific terms, the obligations of good use and any other condition of the concession are determined by decision of the Heraklion Port Authority S.A.

1. The minimum monthly consideration per square meter is set at €1.85 per m² per month for outdoor areas and €4.50 per m² per month for covered areas.

Note: From the entry into force of this tariff and for a period of one (1) year, a twenty percent (20%) reduction on the above charges is applied for all existing users of the respective premises.

For professional shipwrights operating in the port area, no adjustment or increase of the applicable charges is applied during the same period.

2. The monthly consideration may be adjusted from January 1 of each year. The Heraklion Port Authority S.A. may, by a specially reasoned decision of its competent body, determine a consideration other than the above, in special cases, in particular taking into account the nature of the activity, the duration of the concession and the operational needs of the port.
3. The consideration, per square meter, for premises and shops of health interest or provision of non-port or non-related services within the land zone of the Port of Heraklion, may in no case be lower than the above prices. The same applies as a starting price in case of tender procedures.
4. The consideration for special concessions of short-term spaces is determined by decision of the competent body of the Heraklion Port Authority S.A. and in no case can it be lower than the amount of one euro and eighty-five cents (€1.85) per square meter and per day.
5. Monthly concession of use of space for the stay of boats and trailers, not subject to repair work, for boats up to 10 meters in length the amount of 72.58 euros per month and for boats over 10 meters in length the amount of 129.00 euros per month. The above prices are subject to additional VAT.
6. The concessions for the use of spaces within the area of competence of the Heraklion Port Authority S.A. are governed by the applicable provisions of the applicable legislation and the Concession Agreement on the simple concession of the use of spaces, accompanied or not by works of a permanent nature.
